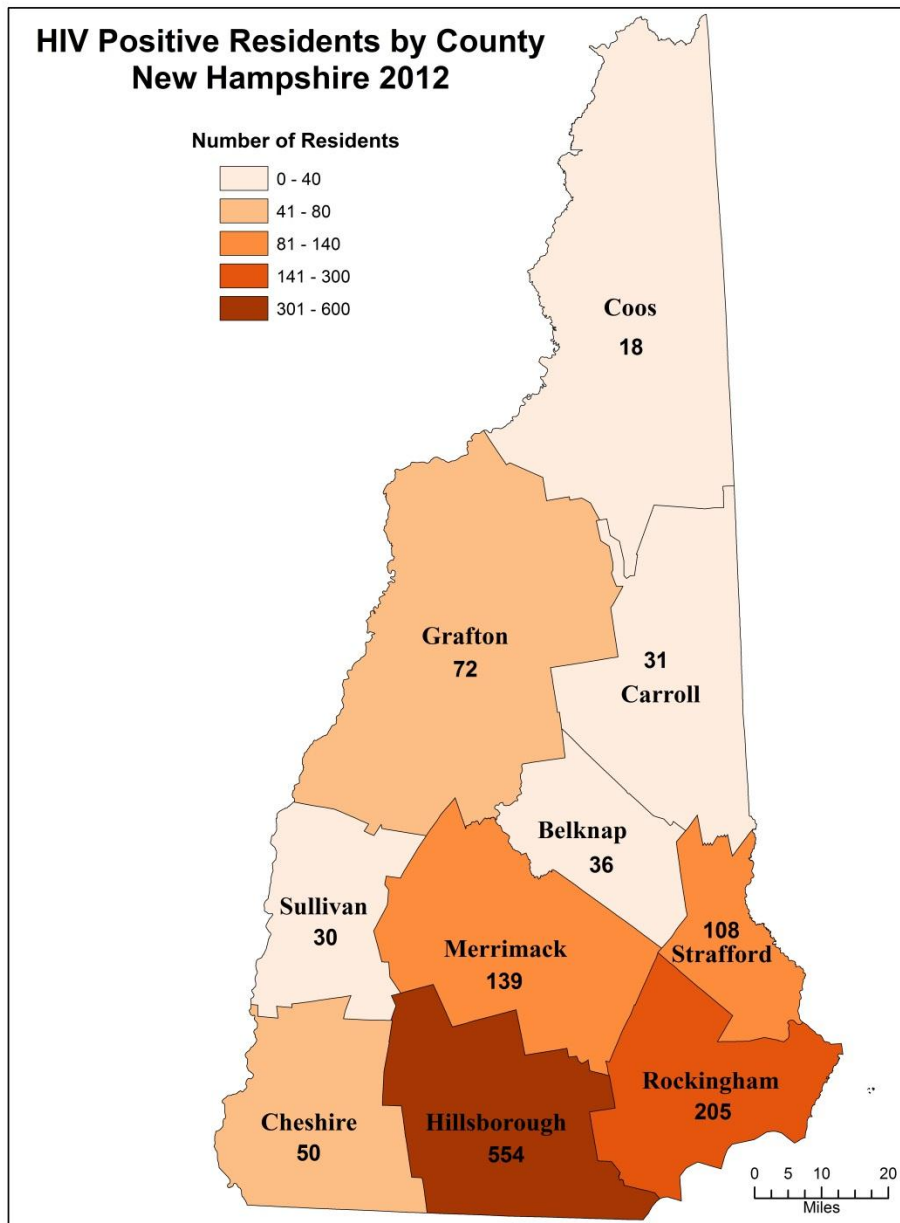


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Basic Epidemiology: HIV in NH

- There are 1,261 PLWHA in NH as of Dec. 31, 2012
- Most PLWHA are older
 - 563/1261 (45%) are age 50 years old or older
- Most PLWHA are among white males
 - 963/1261 (76%) male, 901/1,261 (72%) are white
- Men who have sex with men (MSM) is the most common risk factor 600/1,261 (48%)
- Most PLWHA live in the southern portion of the state
 - 554/1261 (44%) live in Hillsborough county

- Targeted Testing HIV/HCV
 - MSM, Black and Hispanic women and IDU
- Updated Integrated Epi Profile and Comprehensive Needs Assessment
 - Equity focus
 - Consumer and Provider Assessment components
- Recapture/Unmet Need
 - Prevention staff working to reconnect subgroup of HIV+ population in NH with medical care
 - Those who haven't had any evidence of medical visits or routine blood work in >12 months
- HIV Care Continuum

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
